Its objective is to publish articles on current trends of research in Medical and Health Sciences, Life Sciences, Physical Sciences, Built Environment and Spatial Sciences, Engineering, Social Sciences & Humanities, Law, Management, Defence Studies, and Computing, etc.

CRITERIA FOR PUBLICATION

The manuscript submitted for the journal should not be submitted in part or whole (except in the form of an abstract) to any other journal for public or private circulation and no part of this manuscript should be copied from any other source. All authors are required to take total responsibility for the paper's content and to sign the author declaration template downloaded from the KJMS website: <u>Author Declaration | Downloads | KJMS (kdu.ac.lk)</u>. The editorial board will arrange to check the originality of the contents of the manuscript using suitable plagiarism software. The contents of the manuscript should not be copyrighted, submitted, or published elsewhere (including the Internet), in any language, while the manuscript is under consideration for acceptance.

Authors have to confirm that any aspect of the work that has involved either experimental animals or human patients was conducted with the **ethical approval of all relevant bodies**. It is important to indicate such approvals in their methodology section within the manuscript. If required, the KJMS will seek the advice of the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE -

HTTP://WWW.PUBLICATIONETHICS.ORG/) to handle research and publication misconduct cases.

Authors shall go through the author guidelines published by the **KJMS** to prepare their manuscripts. **Entire manuscripts should be about 4000 to 5000 words** (Except for references) and should have an **abstract with a maximum of 300 words**, **keywords a maximum of 6 separated by a comma**, references, and discussion questions as well as any relevant tables, figures, and appendices.

With these guidelines, authors shall use the live template downloadable from KJMS link <u>https://kdu.ac.lk/kjms/downloads/live-template</u> to prepare the manuscript. This KJMS manuscript template is compatible with Microsoft Word 2007 or a later version. The authors have to prepare the manuscript according to the live template and it is mandatory. Do not change the font sizes or line spacing to squeeze more text into a limited number of pages. Use italics for emphasis; do not underline or do not highlight in bold.

The manuscripts that fulfilled the journal's criteria are sent to two referees with the required subject expertise (decided by the editorial board for double-blind peer review) to send their comments. When reviewer comments are sent to the authors, the author shall insert the comments of the reviewers & submit the draft final manuscript within a week and that will be resent to the reviewers for their confirmation for acceptance. Based on the comments and the recommendations of the two referees, the Editor-in-Chief with the consultation of the editorial board has the right to decide on publishing. The board decides whether the paper to (i) accept as it is for the current issue or (ii) kept in the waiting pool for the next issue, resubmitted with revisions, or (iii) be rejected. The corresponding author receives the decision of the Editorial Board.

Submission of Manuscripts

In order to submit your manuscript to KJMS please do the following:

- (2) **It is mandatory to Format the manuscript** in Microsoft Word according to the live template using the headings given in the author guidelines document (Link:<u>https://kdu.ac.lk/kjms/downloads/live-template</u>)
