SUBMISSION OF SAMPLES/PAYMENT OF TESTING CHARGES.

- PERFORMANCE BOND/GUARANTEE. - 14. **DELIVERY.** Preference will be given for early delivery. In case of bulk supplies for locally manufactured items, the delivery of total quantity must be completed within 120 days of signing of contract, unless mutually agreed for extended delivery period with University Hospital Kotelawala Defence University. The bidder/s must indicate the proposed delivery schedule in Annex "E". In the event of placing a purchase order with the successful bidder, the total quantity so ordered must be supplied as one consignment unless part deliveries are agreed upon in the contract. The deliveries not made as per agreed delivery schedule will be considered as bad performances by the suppliers and no extended delivery period will be authorized. Under extreme unavoidable conditions too, the Chairman, Department Procurement Committee (Vice Chancellor of the General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University) reserves the right to grant or refuse delivery period extensions only within the current financial year with or without liquidated claim for delayed deliveries and that decision will be final.
- 15. **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES.** In case of delivery period extensions requested by the successful bidder, a sum equivalent to 2% of the total value of the delayed supply per delay of one week or part thereof may be deducted from the payment due to the supplier from the University Hospital General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University as liquidated damages up to the maximum limit of 10% of the total value of delayed supplies.
