WATER REUSE POLICY

Introduction

The water reuse policy of General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University aims to promote the sustainable and responsible use of water resources by encouraging the recycling and repurposing of treated water for various purposes. This policy is essential for addressing water scarcity, promoting water conservation, and ensuring the efficient utilization of available water supplies.

Policy Objective:

- To save water.
- To increase the use of naturally obtained rainwater.
- To ensure sustainable water use.
- To achieve efficiency in the use of water.
- To repurpose treated water

Implementation

- Establishing separate systems for rainwater collection in all buildings and collecting rainwater from the roofs of the buildings.
- Determine special areas for the reuse of the water stored in the university and develop an action plan.
- Reuse the water treated in the wastewater treatment plant of the University Hospital for gardening and other purposes except for direct consumption-related activities.
- Produce scientific studies and projects for the reuse of water.
- Responsible use of water drawn from tube wells for drinking and consumption in the KDU Sooriyawewa campus.
- Responsible use of the water from ‘Kandawala Lake’ and other internal water bodies of the Ratmalana campus for the purpose of gardening and related activities.

Review

This policy will be reviewed periodically to ensure its effectiveness and compliance with applicable laws and regulations.
