Basic Eligibility Criteria for candidates:

• Completed GCE (A/L) in the year 2022 or Cambridge/ Edexcel (A/L) or equivalent examination in the year 2023 and be qualified for university admission.

o GCE Advanced Level (Local):

Followed Biological Science Stream (Biology, Chemistry and Physics) at the Advanced Level Examination and obtained a minimum of two Credit Passes (C) and one Simple Pass (S) at the GCE (A/L) examination in one sitting.

Or

IGCSE / GCSE (Cambridge) or Advanced Level (Edexcel) or equivalent:
 Followed Biological Science Stream (Biology, Chemistry and Physics) at Cambridge or Edexcel (A/L) Examination and obtained a minimum of two "B" Passes and one "C" pass in one sitting.

- Be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
- Be between 16-24 years of age on the closing date of applications.
- The results should be in one and the same sitting and a maximum of three attempts are allowed.
- Have obtained a pass mark (marks 30 and above) for the Common General Test at the GCE A/L examination.
- Have obtained a minimum of a Credit pass (C) for English Language at the GCE (O/L) examination and minimum of 'C' Grade for English Language at the Cambridge or Edexcel (O/L) examination or equivalent.
- Have obtained a pass mark for the Aptitude Test and for the Structured Interview conducted by the KDU to be selected as a Day Scholar of KDU.
